

ACTS, 1982. - Chaps. 511, 512, 513.

Chap. 511. AN ACT PROVIDING PERMANENT CIVIL SERVICE STATUS TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS IN THE TOWN OF TEWKSBURY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, George DeRoche, Richard Westaway, William Chandler, Jr., Keith Ryan, and Evelyn Doherty, employees of the department of public works in the town of Tewksbury, shall be granted permanent civil service status in their current positions in said department.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 512. AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE REINSTATEMENT OF ROBERT D. WATT AS A MEMBER IN SERVICE IN THE BARNSTABLE COUNTY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, Robert D. Watt shall be reinstated as a member in service in the Barnstable County retirement system, effective May first, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight, provided he pays into the annuity savings fund the amount which he would have paid as regular deductions from his regular compensation had he become a member in service as of such date, including regular interest thereon.
