**Chap. 522. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF OXFORD TO BECOME A PARTICIPATING MEMBER OF THE UPPER BLACKSTONE WATER POLLUTION ABATEMENT DISTRICT.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 752 of the acts of 1968 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

The town of Oxford by vote at a town meeting may become a participating member of the district; provided, however, that the board by a majority vote approves such membership.

**Chap. 523. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BOAT RAMP AT PLYMOUTH HARBOR IN THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH AS THE LEO F. DeMARSH MEMORIAL BOAT RAMP.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The public boat ramp in Plymouth harbor in the town of Plymouth shall be designated and known as the Leo F. DeMarsh Memorial boat ramp in memory of Leo F. DeMarsh a deputy chief engineer of the department of public works. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of environmental management.
