AN ACT FORBIDDING THE USE OF ALUMINUM CONDUCTORS FOR BRANCH CIRCUIT WIRING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The first paragraph of section 3L of chapter 143 of the General
- 2 Laws, as amended by section 18 of chapter 802 of the acts of 1972,
- 3 is hereby further amended by adding at the end of the first sentence
- 4 the following: — ; provided, however, such rules or regulations
- 5 shall not authorize the use of aluminum conductors for branch
- 6 circuit wiring.
