AN ACT RELATIVE TO REAL ESTATE TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause Forty-First of section five of chapter 59 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section one of chapter 347 of
3 the acts of 1974, is hereby further amended by striking out the word
4 "seventy" wherever it so appears, and inserting in place thereof the
5 word: — sixty-five.
