AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COURSES OF INSTRUCTION AT DRIVER'S SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of the first paragraph of section 32G of
2 chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding at the
3 end thereof the following proviso: — ; provided however that no
4 driver school shall be licensed unless it contains as part of its
5 instruction a course in the proper use of an automobile tire jack
6 and the changing of an automobile tire.
