AN ACT EXTENDING THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS IN EMPLOYMENT SECURITY CASES TO SIX YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 47 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 321 of the acts of 1972, is hereby
3 amended by changing paragraph four of this section to read as
4 follows:—

5 “Complaint against any person for a violation of any provision
6 of this section may be made within six years after the date of such
7 violation. All fines collected under this section shall be paid to the
8 director and after clearance shall be deposited in the contingent
9 fund.”
