AN ACT ALLOWING CHARGES AND LIABILITIES FOR AUTOMOBILE TOWING TO BE PAID BY CHECK OR CREDIT CARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 22D of Chapter 40 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "period" in line 30 the
3 following sentence: — Such liability may be paid by personal check
4 or appropriate credit card upon presentation of suitable identifica-
5 tion.

1 SECTION 2. Sections 6B and 6C of Chapter 159B of the
2 General Laws are hereby amended by adding after the first
3 paragraphs the following paragraph: —
4 Such charges may be paid by personal check or appropriate
5 credit card upon presentation of suitable identification.

SECTION 1. Section 1 of the Constitution of the United States of America shall be amended by inserting after the word "people" in the following clause:— "such laws as may be necessary and proper to carry out the foregoing provisions, and such other laws as may be deemed appropriate."

SECTION 2. Section 2 of the Constitution of the United States of America shall be amended by striking out the following clause:— "The Congress shall have the power to lay and collect taxes on incomes, from whatever source derived, such taxes not to exceed the following limits:—"
