

ACTS, 1982. - Chap. 622.

SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 20A of chapter 212 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 121 of chapter 478 of the acts of 1978, is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- The officers so designated shall perform their duties under the direction of the court, and receive such compensation as the chief administrative justice shall establish, except that in Middlesex county the juror pool officers shall receive a salary of not less than twenty-eight thousand one hundred and seventy dollars per annum.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, there shall no longer be any chief juror pool officer in Middlesex county, and there shall be no more than two juror pool officers in said county.

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Chap. 622. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONVEY TO HENRY F. AND RUTH A. RICHARDSON FOR ACCESS PURPOSES TWO ADJACENT TWENTY FOOT EASEMENTS ACROSS THE CHICOPEE VALLEY AQUEDUCT ON CHURCH STREET IN THE TOWN OF LUDLOW.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The division of capital planning and operations is hereby authorized to convey, upon terms and conditions and a sum to be mutually agreed upon, to Henry F. Richardson and Ruth A. Richardson for access purposes of two residential building lots, Lots 18 and 19, on Church street in the town of Ludlow two adjacent twenty foot easements resulting in two twenty foot driveways across the Chicopee Valley aqueduct as depicted in Exhibit #1, on file with the metropolitan district commission, with metes and bounds described as follows, calculated from a map by Richard H. Stowe, Reg. L.S. dated July 23, 1973, recorded with registry of deeds in the county of Hampden in Book of Plans #146, page 9:

Beginning at I.P. S57°-55'-40"E and going south 20 feet;

Thence turning and going S8°-58'-30"E a distance of 54.69 feet;

Thence turning and going N57°-55'-40"W a distance of 20 feet to and I.P.;

Thence continuing 20 feet and turning S8°-58'-30"W to a point;

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Thence turning S57°-55'-40"E for a distance of 20 feet to the point of beginning, containing an area of 2188± square feet.

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Chap. 623. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH TO THE COLUMBIA CULTURAL TRUST, NO. 540 IN THE CITY OF TAUNTON.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 655 of the acts of 1981 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- The division of capital planning and operations, acting in the name of and on behalf of the commonwealth is hereby authorized to grant and convey, by a deed approved as to form by the attorney general, to the Columbia Cultural Trust, No. 540, recorded in the northern district registry of deeds in Bristol county, Book 2145, Page 249, a certain parcel of land under the control of the department of mental health.

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Chap. 624. AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. There shall be in the city of Boston a department known as the environment department which shall provide support staff and resources to enable the following city commissions to carry out their responsibilities as required by law: air pollution control, art commission, Back Bay architectural commission, Beacon Hill architectural commission, Boston landmarks commission, conservation commission.

SECTION 2. The environment department shall be under the charge of a board, known as the commission on the environment, consisting of seven members, known as the environment commissioners, the members being the chairpersons of the commissions set forth in section one and the director of the environment
