

ACTS, 1982. - Chaps. 639, 640.

- Chap. 639. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO GRANT A PERMANENT EASEMENT OVER LAND UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT TO ELIZABETH LARKIN HARKE IN EXCHANGE FOR CERTAIN OTHER LAND.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The division of capital planning and operations, acting for and on behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized to grant to Elizabeth Larkin Harke, her heirs and assigns, and all others who may be lawfully entitled, a permanent easement, approved as to form by the attorney general on a parcel of land in the town of Brewster, under the control of the department of environmental management, for a roadway to be used as ways are commonly used in the town of Brewster, shown as "Easement (60 feet wide)" on a plan of land entitled "Plan of Land in Brewster, Mass. as surveyed and prepared for Elizabeth Larkin Harke, Scale 1" = 40" dated June 8, 1981, Scofield Brothers, Inc., Registered Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors, Route 6A - P.O. Box 101 - Orleans, Mass.," and on file with said department.

SECTION 2. In consideration for said conveyance provided for in section one of this act, Elizabeth Larkin Harke shall convey to the commonwealth for the use of the department of environmental management, all right, title and interest in a certain parcel of land located in the Town of Brewster, shown as Lot 1 on the above-referenced plan, comprising 10,001 square feet, more or less, bounded and described as follows:

Northwesterly by a portion of land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as shown on the hereinbefore-mentioned plan, 129.13 feet; thence Easterly by Lot 2, 117.04 feet; thence Southerly by Massachusetts State Highway Route 6A, 105.58 feet; thence Westerly by a portion of land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, 61.58 feet.

This parcel contains an area of 10,001 square feet more or less.
