By Mr. Cellucci of Hudson, petition of Joseph Greska to credit certain service under the contributory retirement system to permanent-intermittent or call fire fighters appointed as full-time permanent employees of cities and towns. Public Service.

AN ACT CREDITING CERTAIN SERVICE UNDER THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO PERMANENT-INTERMITTENT OR CALL FIREFIGHTERS APPOINTED AS FULL TIME PERMANENT EMPLOYEES OF CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (b) of subdivision (2) of Section 4 of Chapter 32 of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by Chapter 509 of the
3 Acts of 1966, is hereby further amended by inserting at the end
4 thereof the following: — and provided, further, that such service as
5 a permanent-intermittent or call firefighter shall be credited in
6 such amount as the board shall determine not to exceed a
7 maximum of five years, if such permanent-intermittent or call
8 firefighter was later appointed as a full-time permanent employee
9 of the city or town in which he served as a permanent-intermittent
10 or call firefighter.
