

Accompanying the seventh recommendation of the Department of Public Safety (House, No. 155). Ways and Means (joint.)

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Nine.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SEPARATE ACCOUNT WITH THE STATE TREASURER OF FUNDS, INCLUDING GRANTS, BEQUESTS, GIFTS OR CONTRIBUTIONS FROM ANY PERSON BY THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 22 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amend-
2 ed by inserting the following section: —
3 *Section 3C:* The Commissioner may, subject to the approval of
4 the Secretary of Public Safety and the Commissioner of Ad-
5 ministration, apply for and accept on behalf of the Commonwealth
6 any funds, including grants, bequests, gifts or contributions from
7 any person. Such funds shall be deposited in a separate account
8 with the State Treasurer and received by him on behalf of the
9 Commonwealth. All such funds may, subject to rules and
10 regulations promulgated by the Commissioner of Administration,
11 be expended by the Commissioner of Public Safety, in accordance
12 with law.
