The chairman of the industrial accident board shall compute and promulgate such compensation benefits on each October first.

SECTION 2. This act shall apply to injuries arising on and after the effective date of this act.

Chap. 664. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A FULL-TIME APIARY INSPECTOR WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 32 of chapter 128 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 506 of the acts of 1951, is hereby amended by inserting before the first sentence the following:- There shall be within the department a full-time chief apiary inspector to perform the duties of the department relative to a program for the inspection and control of bees, as provided in sections thirty-two through thirty-eight, inclusive. Subject to appropriation, the apiary inspector shall have a staff to perform said duties.

Chap. 665. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE LICENSING OF INSURANCE AGENTS AND BROKERS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 177D the following section:-
Section 177E.

A. The provisions of this section shall apply to resident and nonresident persons licensed to engage in the sale of the following types of insurance:-

- (1) life insurance, annuity contracts, variable annuity contracts and variable life insurance;
- (2) sickness, accident and health insurance;
- (3) all lines of property and casualty insurance;

B. Such resident and nonresident persons licensed as aforesaid shall satisfactorily complete courses or programs of instruction in the minimum number of classroom hours as follows:-
