AN ACT PROVIDING A MANDATORY IMPRISONMENT SENTENCE FOR THE SECOND CONVICTION OF MAKING FALSE REPRESENTATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROCURING A PAYMENT.

— *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1   Whoever has been convicted of any of the offenses set forth in
- 2 section five B of chapter eighteen or section twenty-one of chapter
- 3 one hundred and eighteen E, shall, upon the second conviction
- 4 thereof, receive the maximum sentence provided for in his last
- 5 conviction.
