### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TENURE OF CERTAIN PUBLIC SAFETY INSPECTORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 143 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
2 after section 6 the following section: —

3 *Section 6A.* In a city or town which accepts the provisions of  
4 this section and notwithstanding any provisions of law to the  
5 contrary, a person employed by a city or town for ten consecutive  
6 years or more as a public safety inspector, or in a position involving  
7 similar duties and responsibilities, upon application by such per-  
8 son, shall be certified for such position and shall hold such position  
9 until he attains the age of seventy years.
