AN ACT TO MAKE THE CIVIL SERVICE STATUS OF TEMPORARY PART-TIME SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS EMPLOYED BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION THAT OF PERMANENT SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, all per-
- 2 sons holding the position of temporary part-time school crossing
- 3 guards in the employ of the metropolitan district commission on
- 4 the effective date of this act shall be deemed to be permanent
- 5 employees of said commission and shall have all the rights and
- 6 privileges of other permanent employees under the provisions of
- 7 chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.
- 8 Said crossing guards shall work only such hours as are deemed
- 9 to be necessary by the Commissioner of the Metropolitan District
- 10 Commission for the safe conduct of school children or as may be
- 11 determined by collective bargaining.
