AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ANNUAL OBSERVANCE OF CLERKS OF COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 15CC the following section: —
- 3 *Section DD.* The governor shall annually issue a proclamation
- 4 setting apart the second day of May as Clerks of Court Day in
- 5 recognition of the invaluable service rendered by the clerks of court
- 6 in this commonwealth in the administration of justice and conduct
- 7 of the courts and recommending that the day be observed by jurists
- 8 and the legal profession by appropriate ceremony.
