AN ACT REGULATING INVESTIGATIONS OF PERSONS LICENSED TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 63A of Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
3 Authorized investigations of the Commission or investigators,
4 inspectors or other authorized agents of local licensing authorities
5 shall seek information concerning the conduct of the licensed busi-
6 ness, except sales to minors, from the named licensee, or in the
7 case of a corporation licensee from the manager of record or in the
8 absence of a manager of record from a corporate officer and from no
9 other, unless it be shown that such licensee, manager or corporate
10 officer is not available on twenty-four (24) hour notice.
