AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE GRANTING OF LICENSES FOR PACKAGE STORES, SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 15 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by striking out the second sentence and inserting in its place the
- 3 following: —
- 4 “No person, firm, corporation, association or other combination
- 5 of persons, directly or indirectly, or through any agent, employee,
- 6 stockholder, officer or other person or any subsidiary whatsoever,
- 7 shall be granted, in the aggregate, more than fifteen such licenses.”
