AN ACT REQUIRING THE USE OF TWO NUMBER PLATES ON MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as most recently
2 amended by chapter 207 of the acts of 1971, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: —

5 Every motor vehicle or trailer registered under this chapter when
6 operated in or on any way in this commonwealth shall have its
7 register number displayed conspicuously thereon by the number
8 plates furnished by the registrar in accordance with section two or
9 five or by temporary number plates authorized by the registrar as
10 hereinafter provided one number plate to be attached at the front
11 and one at the rear of said motor vehicle, and one number plate to
12 be attached at the rear of said trailer.
