AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FROM CONSTRUCTING ANY PEDESTRIAN AND/OR VEHICULAR ACCESS ROUTES FROM INDEPENDENCE AVENUE IN SOUTH QUINCY TO THE PROPOSED SOUTH QUINCY MBTA STATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary the
- 2 Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority is hereby prohibited
- 3 from constructing any pedestrian and/or vehicular access routes
- 4 from Independence Avenue in South Quincy to the proposed
- 5 South Quincy MBTA Station.
