AN ACT TO AMEND THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 25 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 813 of the Acts of 1974 is hereby further
3 amended by striking the second sentence of the fourth paragraph
4 and inserting in place thereof the following: —

5 “Whenever the license of any licensee whose name appears on
6 the delinquent list is transferred, the name of the transferee shall
7 appear in the place and stead of the transferor as of the date of the
8 license transfer, in the same manner as if no transfer had occurred,
9 but the provisions of this sentence shall not apply to transfers of
10 licenses by receivers or trustees proceeding under authority of the
11 Bankruptcy Act, provided that prior approval of such transfer by a
12 receiver or trustee is obtained from the Commission after notice to
13 all creditors has been given and reasonable time allowed for objec-
14 tions by such creditors.”
