AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A CERTAIN AMOUNT BE EXPENDED EACH YEAR FROM THE STATE RECREATION AREAS FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING THE NANTUCKET STATE FOREST.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section ten of chapter one
2 hundred and thirty-two A of the General Laws or the provisions of
3 any other law to the contrary, not less than thirty-five thousand
4 dollars shall be expended each year by the department of environ-
5 mental management from the state recreation areas fund for the
6 purpose of improving the Nantucket state forest.
