## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE CLOSING OF BRANCH OFFICES OF THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE GENERAL COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary, no
- 2 branch office of the Registry of Motor Vehicles shall be closed
- 3 without expressed consent of the General Court.
