## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Nine.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR DEPUTY SHERIFFS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
2 after section 5 the following section: —

3 *Section 5A.* Deputy sheriffs who have served in the capacity as  
4 court officers in the superior or probate courts for not less than  
5 fifty days for a period of not less than three years prior to January  
6 first, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine shall be eligible for mem-  
7 bership in the state retirement system upon payment of the  
8 appropriate contributions.
