AN ACT PROVIDING CERTAIN FUNDS FROM THE STATE TREASURY FOR THE OFFICE OF TOURISM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary, one-third of all funds collected by the commonwealth
3 shall be transferred from the state treasury to the office of tourism,
4 said funds to be used for advertising and tourism in the
5 commonwealth.
