AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PILOT PROGRAMS FOR CERTAIN STATE-WIDE UNERTAKINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 A department, board, commission or agency of the common-  
2 wealth which has undertaken a state-wide program involving large  
3 expenditures of funds shall first initiate a pilot program to deter-  
4 mine the cost and impact on the tax structure of the common-  
5 wealth. If said program is found to be financially stable it may then  
6 be initiated state wide.
