AN ACT RELATIVE TO COUNTY CREDIT UNIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 428 of the Acts of 1978 is hereby amended by inserting
2 after the fourth paragraph of section 328, the following para-
3 graph: —

4 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all
5 employees of the remaining thirteen counties who are paid by the
6 respective county treasurers immediately prior to the effective date
7 of this act, including but not limited to, the employees of the
8 Superior Court, Housing Courts, the Probate Courts, and all
9 District and Municipal Courts in the thirteen remaining counties,
10 shall be allowed to remain as members of their respective county
11 employees credit unions, or by whatever common name the indi-
12 vidual county employee credit union is named, immediately prior
13 to the effective date of this act, with all rights and benefits including
14 payroll deductions.

15 Employees desiring to remain as members shall notify their
16 immediate superiors as well as each respective credit union in
17 writing within sixty days and the said immediate superior shall
18 make all necessary arrangements including the necessary deduc-
19 tions from the employees paycheck.
