## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ANY MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICER'S POWER TO ARREST SHALL EXTEND THROUGHOUT THE COMMONWEALTH FOR FELONIES COMMITTED IN THE PRESENCE OF SAID MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 98 of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by chapter 181 of the acts of 1970, is hereby further
- 3 amended by adding the following paragraph:—
- 4 The chief and other police officers of all cities and towns who are
- 5 empowered to make arrests within a city or town may exercise such
- 6 authority in any other city or town for any felony committed in
- 7 their presence.
