An ACT CLARIFYING THE OFFENSE OF IDLE AND DISORDERLY PERSON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 272 of section 53 of the General Laws as most recently
- 2 amended by the acts of 1973, chapter 1073, is hereby further
- 3 amended as follows:
- 4 Section 53 of chapter 272 of the General Laws, is hereby
- 5 amended by striking out the words idle and disorderly person, and
- 6 inserting a new section 53, A — defining the offense of Disorderly
- 7 Conduct.
