RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO REGULATION OF BUS SAFETY STANDARDS.

1 *Resolved*, That a Special Commission, to consist of three
2 members of the Senate, five members of the House of Representa-
3 tives, the Registrar of Motor Vehicles or his/her designee, the
4 Commissioner of Public Safety or his/her designee, the Commis-
5 sioner of Public Utilities or his/her designee, and two members
6 appointed by the Governor, is hereby established for the purpose
7 of making an investigation and study relative to the establishment
8 and enforcement of stringent safety standards governing the
9 design, equipment, maintenance and operation of busses used to
10 transport children to and from school or school-related functions
11 and elderly groups to and from places (including but not limited
12 to) of residence, recreation or business. This Commission shall
13 report from time to time to the General Court the results of its
14 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together
15 with drafts of such legislation as may be necessary to carry such
16 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of
17 the House of Representatives and shall file its final report not later
18 than the last Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and
19 seventy-nine.
