### AN ACT RELATIVE TO IMPASSE PROCEDURES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 150E, Section 9 of the General Laws is amended by
- 2 adding as the 3rd sentence of the 4th paragraph the following: —
- 3 Such petition shall invest the Board with an exclusive jurisdic-
- 4 tion over the parties and the Commission shall not receive, hear or
- 5 decide any representation petition pending either the resolution of
- 6 impasse or after the fact finder's findings and recommendations
- 7 have been made public for a period of 30 days, whichever comes
- 8 first.
