AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY TO PAY CERTAIN UNPAID BILLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The County Commissioners of Middlesex County are hereby
2 authorized to pay from available funds, certain unpaid bills total-
3 ing Fifty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two Dollars
4 and Forty-Seven Cents, (\$58,952.47) for services rendered to said
5 County during the years Nineteen Hundred and Seventy-Four
6 through Nineteen Hundred and Seventy-Eight which are legally
7 unenforceable.
