By Mr. Switzler of Wellesley, petition of Norman Meyer that provision be made for the abolition of aerial spraying by pesticides for the killing of adult mosquitoes. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ABOLITION OF AERIAL SPRAYING BY PESTICIDES ON AN ANNUAL BASIS FOR THE ADULTICIDING OF NUISANCE MOSQUITOES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The routine aerial spraying by pesticides for the killing of adult
- 2 mosquitoes is hereby prohibited. Such adulticiding because of
- 3 "nuisance" complaints must be accomplished for clear and present
- 4 danger health considerations only.
