

By Mr. Businger of Brookline, petition of John A. Businger that the town of Brookline be reimbursed by the Commonwealth for overdue payments for urban renewal projects. Ways and Means (House).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT TO THE TOWN OF BROOKLINE OF ALL REIMBURSEMENTS IN ARREARS FOR URBAN RENEWAL PROJECTS U.R. MASS. 15-1 AND MASS. R-37.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Section 55(d) of Chapter 121B
2 of the General Laws, the Treasurer of the Commonwealth of
3 Massachusetts, upon the certification to the Comptroller by the
4 Department of Community Affairs, is hereby directed to pay to
5 the Town of Brookline the sum of \$480,475.25, being the amount
6 due under said statute through fiscal 1974 presently in arrears for
7 the Farm (U.R. Mass. 15-1) and Marsh (Mass. R-37) urban
8 renewal projects in accordance with the "twenty equal in-
9 stallments" provision of Section 55(c) of said Chapter.

1 SECTION 2. Section 55(d) of Chapter 121B of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by changing "three and one half million
3 dollars" to "\$3,980,475.25" and "seventy million dollars" to
4 "\$70,480,475.25" so that the section reads as follows:—
5 "(d) The total amount of urban renewal assistance grants to be
6 paid under the provisions of this section shall not exceed
7 \$3,980,475.25 in any one fiscal year or a total of \$70,480,475.25 in
8 the aggregate."

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect immediately upon its
2 passage.
