AN ACT PROHIBITING IMPOSITION OF LONG-DISTANCE TELEPHONE CHARGES FOR CERTAIN CALLS WITHIN BARNSTABLE COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 166 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 15D the following section:—
- 3 *Section 15E.* No telephone company offering service in the
- 4 county of Barnstable shall impose any long-distance toll charge for
- 5 any telephone call placed from a point in such county to another
- 6 point in such county within forty miles of the point of origination.
