AN ACT DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A RECREATION BUILDING CONTAINING SIX INDOOR TENNIS COURTS ON THE VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS PARKWAY IN THE WEST ROXBURY DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to construct and maintain a recreation building
- 3 containing six indoor tennis courts on the veterans of foreign wars
- 4 parkway in the West Roxbury district of the city of Boston. For
- 5 such purposes said commission may expend such sums as may be
- 6 appropriated therefor.
