RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO PROVIDING HEALTH CARE TO REDUCE THE HIGH INFANT MORTALITY RATE.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three mem-
2 bers of the senate, five members of the house of representatives, the
3 secretary of human services or his dsignee, the commissioner of
4 public health or his designee and five persons to be appointed by
5 the governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an
6 investigation and study into the development of plans for mobiliz-
7 ing appropriate health care and fiscal resources in order to reduce
8 the high infant mortality rate.
