

HOUSE No. 5226

By Mr. Fallon of Clinton, petition of Thomas F. Fallon (by vote of the town) that the Metropolitan District commission be directed to transfer certain land to the town of Clinton. Urban Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN LAND BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO THE TOWN OF CLINTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to convey to the town of Clinton, upon
3 such terms and conditions as are mutually acceptable, two parcels
4 of land situated in said town and described as follows:—

5 Parcel 1. A 42 ± acre tract of land located on the westerly side of
6 Route #110, formerly used for such purposes as State-operated
7 nurseries and watershed.

8 Parcel 2. A small 4 acres ± piece of land on the northerly side of
9 Willow Road (Route #62), presently under the jurisdiction of the
10 Metropolitan District Commission. This land is presently used as
11 watershed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
