AN ACT MAKING A CERTAIN CHANGE IN THE PROBATE LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 191 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 3 of chapter 515 of the acts of
3 1976, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 4, the word
4 "two", and inserting in place thereof the word: — three.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2 of said chapter 191, as most recently
2 amended by section 5 of said chapter 515 of the acts of 1976, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out, in line 5, the word "two"
4 and inserting in place thereof the word: — three.
