## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Nine.

AN ACT TO ALLOW CITIES AND TOWNS TO APPOINT ONE PERSON TO THE METROPOLITAN AREA PLANNING COUNCIL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 24 of Chapter 40B of the Massachusetts General Laws,  
2 as amended by Chapter 849 of the Acts of 1970, and Chapters 163  
3 and 706 of the Acts of 1975, is hereby further amended by insert-  
4 ing after "Said council shall consist of one representative" as it  
5 appears in the second sentence of Section 24 of Chapter 40B of the  
6 Massachusetts General Laws the following words: — selected by  
7 the planning board of each city and town of the metropolitan area  
8 planning district and one representative.
