AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE POSSESSION OF FIREARMS BY NON-RESIDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 129-C of Chapter 140 of the Massachu-
2 setts General Laws is hereby amended by adding the word "fire-
3 arms," before the word "rifles" as such word appears in paragraph
4 (g) of said Section 129-C, and in paragraph (i) of said Section
5 129-C.

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph (h) of Section 129-C of Chapter 140 is
2 hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "(h) Possession of firearms, rifles, and shotguns and ammuni-
4 tion therefor by nonresidents traveling in or through the common-
5 wealth, providing that any rifles or shotguns are unloaded and
6 enclosed in a case, and any firearms are unloaded and locked in a
7 case."
