## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Nine.**

AN ACT TO PROVIDE TENURE OF OFFICE OF MICHAEL A. PERRY, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The tenure of office of Michael A. Perry, incumbent of the Office  
2 of Chairman of the Board of Election Commissioners of the City of  
3 New Bedford, shall be unlimited as the full-time member of said  
4 board during good behavior until he attains age seventy, unless  
5 incapacitated by physical or mental disability from performing the  
6 duties thereof, but he may be removed for cause after hearing in the  
7 manner provided by Section forty-three of Chapter 31 of the  
8 General Laws.
