AN ACT RELATIVE TO FEES CHARGED TO NON-RESIDENTS AT STATE CAMPING AREAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (2) of section 2D of Chapter 132A of the General
2 Laws, as inserted by section one of chapter 656 of the Acts of 1958
3 is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following
4 two sentences: — Fees charged to persons who are not residents
5 of the commonwealth, for the use of state camping areas, shall be at
6 least one dollar per night greater than the fee charged to residents.
7 Monies received on account of these additional fees shall be
8 expended by the State Recreation Areas Fund to hire additional
9 security guards.
