RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY OFFICE OF COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT, WITHIN THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS, RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE BELLE ISLE MARSH AS A CONSERVATION AREA.

1 *Resolved*, That the office of coastal zone management, within
2 the executive office of the secretary of environmental affairs, is
3 hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
4 relative to the subject matter of current house document numbered
5 689, relative to establishing the Belle Isle Marsh as a conservation
6 area. Said office shall report to the general court the results of its
7 investigation and study, and its recommendation, if any, together
8 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recommendations
9 into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
10 representatives on or before December first, nineteen hundred and
11 eighty.
