

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 5718

By Mr. Marotta of Medford, petition of Angelo Marotta that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to abandon its interest in a parcel of land located on Highland Avenue in the city of Medford. Urban Affairs.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Nine.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO ABANDON ITS INTEREST IN A PARCEL OF LAND ON HIGHLAND AVENUE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The Metropolitan District Commission is hereby authorized to  
2 convey the triangular portion of land located at 906 Highland  
3 Avenue, Medford to Wyett Estate owners of said property at 906  
4 Highland Avenue, Medford shown on attached plan consisting of  
5 approximately 600 square feet more or less.

6 The abandonment of this parcel will not be detrimental to the  
7 commonwealth but will clear the title of the owner by releasing to  
8 them an encroachment that presently exists.

The House of Representatives of the United States of America, in Congress assembled, do hereby pass the following resolution:

**The Constitution of the United States**

is hereby affirmed to be the supreme Law of the Land.

Resolved, That the President and Vice President of the United States shall be elected by the Electors in each State.

Resolved, That the President shall hold his Office for four Years, and shall be eligible for Re-election only once.

The President shall have the Honor and Power of Pardoning all Crimes except Treason, Bribery, and Crimes against the United States. He shall have the Power to grant Reprieves and Fines, and to suspend the Execution of all Penalties except in Cases of Treason, Bribery, and Crimes against the United States.
