AN ACT TO AMEND THE TENURE OF EMPLOYEES AND EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS OF HOUSING AUTHORITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 29 of chapter 121B of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the fifth paragraph and inserting in place
3 thereof the following paragraph:—

4 No employee of a housing authority, including the executive
5 director, who has held his office or position, including any promo-
6 tion or reallocation therefrom within the authority for a total
7 period of five years of uninterrupted service, shall be involuntarily
8 separated therefrom except subject to and in accordance with the
9 provisions of sections forty-three and forty-five of said chapter
10 thirty-one to the same extent as if said office or position were
11 classified under said chapter.
