AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIVISION OF WATERWAYS,  
WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ENGINEER-  
ING TO CONSTRUCT A RETAINING WALL ON SPY POND IN THE TOWN OF  
ARLINGTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The division of waterways, within the department of environ-  
2 mental quality engineering is hereby authorized and directed to  
3 construct a retaining wall behind the Arlington Boys Club and the  
4 Arlington Lodge of Elks on the shores of Spy Pond in the town of  
5 Arlington for the purposes of correcting the riparian decrement in  
6 accordance with the provision of chapter ninety-one of the general  
7 laws.
