*Ordered*, That the Joint Committee on Banks and Banking is hereby authorized to sit during the current session and during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to the financing of an automobile if the title is in the name of a minor for the purpose of obtaining handicapped plates. The Committee shall, in the course of its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of current House document numbered 1507, relative to financing automobiles of handicapped minors.

Said Committee may report from time to time to the General Court the results of its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect.
