RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL
RELATIVE TO PROVISION BEING MADE FOR THE GARNISHMENT OF
CERTAIN WAGES AND BENEFITS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FULFILLING
CHILD SUPPORT OBLIGATIONS.

1 *Resolved*, That the judicial council be requested to investigate
2 the subject matter of current house document numbered H. 2955,
3 relative to provision being made for the garnishment of certain
4 wages and benefits for the purpose of fulfilling child support
5 obligations, and to include its conclusions and its recommenda-
6 tions, if any, in relation thereto, together with drafts of such
7 legislation as may be necessary to give effect to the same, in its
8 annual report for the current year.
