AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO THE TOWN OF NAHANT FOR EXPENSES INCURRED AS A RESULT OF THE COASTAL STORM WHICH SWEEPED THROUGH SAID TOWN ON JANUARY THE TWENTY-FIFTH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The commonwealth shall, subject to the board  
2 established by section two of chapter six hundred and eighty-four  
3 of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, reimburse the town  
4 of Nahant a sum not exceeding one hundred and twenty thousand  
5 dollars on account of expenses incurred in cleaning and repair of  
6 public highways and public lands resulting from damage caused by  
7 a coastal storm which swept through said town on January the  
8 twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine.

1 SECTION 2. Any unexpended funds made available by section  
2 seven of chapter six hundred and thirty-six of the acts of nineteen  
3 hundred and seventy-two may be used to meet the expenditures  
4 necessary to carry out the provisions of this act.
